The Eco- Club in collaboration with the PTA Committee, successfully organised a series of informative and engaging sessions. Workshop was conducted on Environmental Sustainability on 22 April 2026. The sessions were conducted by two resource persons. During the first session the talk was by Ms. Janice Gomes Horticulture Scientist at Krishi Vigyan Kendra (South Goa). on the topic "Water Conservation"

She highlighted the importance of preserving these vital resources in the face of growing scarcity. Participants were introduced to simple yet effective methods such as rainwater harvesting, reducing water wastage and adopting mindful usage in daily life.

The second session was by Ms. Leona Fernandes, Botany teacher at Carmel Higher Secondary, Nuvemon the topic "Vermicomposting and Oyster Mushroom Cultivation". The session on Vermicomposting provided hands-on knowledge about converting organic waste into nutrient- rich compost using earthworms. Adding to this, the workshop on oyster mushroom cultivation sparked great interest among the participants. Experts demonstrated the step-by-step process of growing mushrooms at home. Around 170 students participated for this session along with the teachers.
